20.	1	Vase of Antirrhinums, any one variety – min 3, max 5 spikes
21.	1	Vase of Marigolds (French – <i>Tagetes</i>), any one variety – 5 blooms
22.	1	Vase of Marigolds (Scotch – <i>Calendula</i>), any one variety – 5 blooms
23.	1	Vase of Phlox, any one variety – min 3, max 5 spikes
