Floral Arrangement

Prizes for each class: £10 first, £7 second, £5 third;
if any class exceeds 6 entries a 4th prize of £3 will be awarded

**Staging times: Friday 2 pm – 9pm, Saturday 7 – 9am
for *final assembly only*; displays to be made at home
Entries must be lodged with the Treasurer by Monday evening

The use of oasis is not permitted as bio-floral foam (oasis) is now readily available

The background is pale green. Dimensions allowed are, unless stated otherwise, width 90cm (41”), depth 65cm (26”) and height 100cm (39”)

An exhibit is plant material, with or without accessories. Backgrounds, bases, containers, drapes, exhibit titles and mechanics may always be included in an exhibit unless otherwise stated. Natural plant material means fresh, dried or preserved. All back drapes must be free standing. Artificially coloured plant material may be used unless otherwise stated in the schedule. The cut ends of all fresh plant material must be in water or water-retaining material. Succulents, cacti, moss and lichen, fruit, vegetables and long-lasting plant material which will remain turgid for the duration of the Show are excepted.

- 87. **‘Leaves are not always Green’** An exhibit of natural garden plant material featuring fresh foliage
- 88. **‘New Beginnings’** An exhibit of natural plant material, state the occasion
- 89. **‘Trio’** An exhibit in the contemporary style, only 3 blooms allowed, width 61cm (24”)
- 90. **‘Strike a Light’** A petite exhibit using a match box & natural plant material, not to exceed 25cm (10”) in width and depth, height may be up to 37cm (14.5”)
- 91. **‘Climate Change’** An exhibit featuring natural plant material, width 40cm (16”)
- 92. **‘Over the Garden Fence’** An exhibit using natural plant material
- 93. **‘Harvest’** An exhibit featuring natural plant material;
