make it circular, square or rectangular – max size 40cm x 40cm

- 123. A headdress/band made from any natural materials
- 124. A picture of *My Friend* using paint, crayon, pencil,
felt pen etc. – max size A4
- 125. *I Grew this Vegetable*; all vegetables accepted, big, small, mis-shapen and even unripe
- 126. *I Watched them Grow*; 15cm pot of wildflowers grown from seed (Tip: you will need to plant these in
